## Salary Scale Info:

In accordance with our last collective agreement, 2022-2023 is the year that the removal of a step on our salary scale goes into effect.

As such, teachers at Step 17 will henceforth be at Step 16, with Step 16 becoming the last step on the scale.

Teachers at all steps, aside from Steps 1, 2, and 17, will remain at their current step number for the next school year, but have received a pay raise as of the 139th day (March 29th, 2023).

Future raises will depend on our next collective agreement, currently under negotiation. D- Salary scale
