CO2 Monitoring



As the cold weather comes in and the heating systems come on, we may start to worry about the CO2 levels in our classrooms. Here is a reminder of the acceptable levels:

Critical: > 2000 ppm

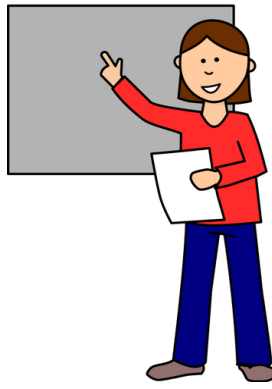
Limit: 1500-2000 ppm

Acceptable: 1000-1500 ppm

Optimal: < 1000 ppm

Material Resources monitors the levels in our classrooms and watches for daily average readings.

The readings are taken between the school hours of 8:00am - 4:00pm. The specific readings at specific times are not as important as the daily average. If you are concerned about the levels in your classroom, speak to your administrator, who also has access to the readings.



STUDENT TEACHER MONIES

Student Teacher Money for the 2021-2022 school year will be paid out on the December 22, 2022 paycheck.

Please Note: **Student Teacher money for previous years will expire on April 15th, 2023**, at which point the money will be sent to schools' councils.

If this applies to you, notify your administrator to have these amounts paid out to you before this date.

Starting this school year, the Student Teacher amount will increase to \$1 000, with only 5% being withdrawn to RSB, and the remainder being paid out directly to the Supervising Teacher at the end of the school year.
