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Health Standards Updates



Following the latest RSB Health and Safety meeting we wanted to share what the number scale for the CO2 readings are.

Critical: > 2000ppm
Limit: 1500-2000ppm
Acceptable: 1000-1500ppm
Optimal: < 1000ppm

Material Resources is monitoring the readings and looking at the overall average. The average is taken during school hours 8:00-4:00pm. Spikes in the readings are not as important as the overall average.

Any class that has a high overall average will be looked into by Material Resource.

If you have any questions about your classroom readings you can contact your administration who also has access to the readings.
